The SHERMAN COUNTY conducted public hearings on August 30, 2019 and September 6, 2019 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the SHERMAN COUNTY from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 3.000129 percent.

The total tax revenue raised last year at last year's tax rate of 0.674690 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$3,890,553.84.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of 0.700920 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$4,007,274.00.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of 0.700920 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$4,022,722.48.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in SHERMAN COUNTY last year was \$78,954. Based on last year's tax rate of \$0.674690 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed last year on the average home was \$532.69.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in SHERMAN COUNTY this year is \$87,762. If the governing body adopts the effective tax rate for this year of \$0.680504 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$597.22.

If the governing body adopts the proposed tax rate of \$0.700920 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$615.14.
